

### Fairtrade Statement

BG and BGSU, in keeping with the character of a University Church College, strive to achieve the highest ethical standards in all areas of its life. Therefore the University College and Students' Union are committed to supporting, using, and promoting Fairtrade.

In order to achieve this, we are committed to the goals laid down by the Fairtrade Foundation. These are:

1. that Fairtrade products will be made available through the campus shop and catering outlets of all types. Where this is not currently possible, there is a commitment to begin use of Fairtrade products as it does become possible;
2. that the University College and Students' Union will serve Fairtrade products at all meetings, conferences, and hospitality events, with a commitment to increase the use of Fairtrade products as it becomes possible to do so;
3. that the University College and Students' Union will promote the awareness, understanding, and use of Fairtrade products across the campus;
4. that the University College has established a Fairtrade Steering Group, whose members are drawn from different sections of the University College and student bodies too. This Group will meet once a term to oversee the implementation of the Fairtrade Statement, and prepare an annual review of progress for the Fairtrade Foundation.
